## Lodging

Lodging for this trip will be at the Ron Beach Hotel on the shore of the Sea of Gallilee and at the Gloria Hotel, just inside the Jaffa Gate of the Old City. These locations allow participants to enjoy the Gallilee and the city of Jerusalem.

## Cost

**Including flights from and returning to Chicago: \$4,365.** If you arrange your own transportation the cost is **\$3,200 land only** (includes lodging at the Gloria Hotel in the Old City of Jerusalem and at the Ron Beach Hotel on the shores of the Sea of Galilee). **Single room supplement is: \$950.**
