



# CRIES AND DREAMS

By choosing the Amazonia, the whole Dominican Family of the region is asked to participate in the elaboration of the material to be distributed about the reality of injustice in this region, and the Dominican Family of Peru is asked to lead and coordinate this work.

Based on the Apostolic Exhortation **Dear Amazonia** written by Pope Francis, we are going to work on the following methodological framework using four approaches that will allow us to enter the world of Amazonia (**EA QA 7**):

**THE CRY OF THE LAND:** *"I dream of an Amazonia that guards the overwhelming natural beauty that adorns it, the overflowing life that fills its rivers and jungles".*

**THE CRY OF THE POOR:** *"I dream of an Amazonia that fights for the rights of the poorest, of the original peoples, of the excluded, where their voice is heard, and their dignity is promoted".*

**CULTURAL DREAM - EDUCATION:** *"I dream of an Amazon that preserves the cultural richness that makes it stand out, where human beauty shines in so many different ways".*

**AN ECCLESIAL DREAM - VOLUNTEERING:** *"I dream of Christian communities capable of giving themselves and becoming incarnated in the Amazonia, to the point of giving the Church new faces with Amazonian features".*

Using this outline, we will find Lights and Shadows that appear in the Amazonia in the middle of each area that represents a call that the Amazonia makes to the Dominican Family. Each week we will develop each Cry or Call that will insert us into the reality of what is being experienced in this majestic Region of the World.
